Course Description

Chinese II is a basic language course built on top of Chinese I with the expectation that student will master more in terms of degree and quantity. There will be further focus on the mechanics of stroke order, pinyin and radicals in learning Chinese characters. The students will continue to build vocabulary and learn grammar to help them to express themselves with more confidence in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. In addition, they will learn how to build more complex sentences to write practical Chinese letters and special topic essays. The Chinese culture, history, and tradition will be continued to enhance the Chinese language.

Class Procedures

Homework and Make-ups

Homework assignments are a great opportunity to practice, reflect and review.

- Late homework will be counted **70%** of the grade. Missing homework are graded as 0 until the make-up work is submitted within the grading period.
- Make arrangement before absences. School policy allows **TWO days** for make-up work to be completed for each day a student is absent. In case of extenuating circumstances, more time can be given.
